

DRIVER CHECKLIST

FOR CBH MOBILE APPLICATIONS

CBH's Rover and Domestics mobile applications (apps) are used to facilitate the outturn and movement of grain from and to CBH sites and end-users.

The apps feature self-weighing, in-app site inductions, easy access to site information and contact details, access to load details and electronic paperwork.

Drivers who move grain for CBH or grain owners, including sub-contractors, are required to use the apps at all times.

CBH Rover is for completing CBH site to site grain movements.

CBH Domestics is for picking up grain from CBH sites to deliver to domestic end-users.

Please use this checklist to ensure you are set up and ready to start using the app.

SitePass & Truck Registration

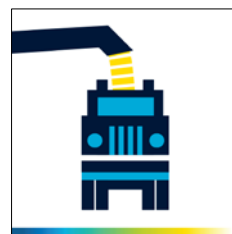
- Ensure you have a valid [SitePass](#) ID
- Obtain a PIN from your employer – you will need this to log in to the apps with your SitePass ID
- Ensure your truck is registered with CBH
- Download the CBH apps for your Android or Apple iOS mobile or tablet devices.

Download the Apps

- Ensure you have a compatible device
 - **Android** (Samsung, HTC, Huawei, Sony, LG etc) with an operating system of 5.0 or higher
 - **Apple** iOS with operating system of 9.0 or higher
- CBH Rover app available from the [Google Play](#) store and is for Android devices only
- CBH Domestics app available from the [Google Play](#) and [Apple](#) stores for Android and iOS devices
- Check you can log in to the apps using your [SitePass](#) ID and employer PIN
