Sites identified for retirement may be offered for lease or sale in the first instance as part of an Expression of Interest (EOI) process, and we encourage growers and community groups to register their interest. Under the EOI process, an entire individual site will be available for lease or purchase inclusive of land and buildings, unless otherwise specified.

Expressions of interest for a portion of the site will not be considered.

CBH will undertake a program of works to ensure the site is safe for lease. Sale sites will be sold as is.

Sites will be made available for lease or purchase following the completion of the EOI process.
